The Cursillo Commission has scheduled 3 weekends for 2009:

March 12-15	Coed
April 2-5	Men's
October 1-4	Coed

Making these weekends happen depends on you!!

Over the last several years there have been fewer and fewer applications for Weekends and many of them are not being received until a couple weeks to a day before a Weekend. This makes it

impossible to calculate the number of people attending, and requires the Commission to pay any balance due the retreat center when a Weekend is not full.

Weekends have become more expensive to run. To continue to hold Weekends with too few candidates is poor stewardship of our funds.

The Commission has scheduled these dates with the understanding that if we do not have a enough candidates to fill a Weekend 91 days prior to the

Weekend date, it will be canceled and the commission will incur a \$100 penalty.

Your challenge is to re-awaken, renew and revitalize Cursillo in your parish, to encourage leaders and potential leaders to commit to this movement.

Weekend Fees: what they cover / get help with funding

The weekend fee for 2009 will be \$240. This fee includes 3 nights lodging and 8 full meals plus snacks.

The Commission will provide \$25 toward this fee.

The **cost of a weekend should NEVER be an obstacle** in submitting applications or accepting an invitation to attend a

Weekend. Here are some ways to trim the cost to prospective candidates:

Sponsors, include your check for \$25 along with the candidate's initial \$25 when submitting an application. Ask your **priest** to write a \$25 check from his/her discretionary funds for each candidate. **Groupies**

and/or parish Cursillistas pledge another \$25 (or more) per candidate. So far, this adds up to \$100 per person.

Other revenue sources: Ask your deanery or regional **Ultreya group** to give scholarships from monies collected from Ultreyas.

The candidate's priest may request funding from the **Cursillo Commission** by e-mailing the Chair, Pam Kirk. The candidate's priest may also request scholarship funds from **Canterbury** (e-mail the Chair to request help from Canterbury).

Help candidates live the Cursillo weekend, the Three Days That Will Last A Lifetime.
